## Genes & Environment Best Paper Award

- 1. The Japanese Environmental Mutagen Society (JEMS) bestows annually a "Best Paper Award" to a prominent paper published in the society's journal, Genes and Environment.
- 2. This award aims to encourage young researchers to contribute to JEMS and to the society's journal, Genes and Environment.
- 3. One paper among those published in the preceding year can receive the award, and all of the authors (excluding non-JEMS members) will be awarded.
- 4. Award selection is done by the end of March of each year, and the winning authors will be awarded a diploma at the annual meeting of JEMS by the President of JEMS.
